He easily gets along and enjoys whatever the rest of us involve him in. When we spend time at the PT Center where we rear goats and pigs, he closely attempts to take care of these farm livestock as best as he can, with interest.



Considerably, he is growing well in his two homes – sometimes with his father and other times with his mother and us. He goes to kindergarten at Daffodils Early Learning Center and enjoys making friends. He is very social and easily fits among others.

Sometimes taking his turn to give thanks for a meal, he offers lengthy petitions that include his school, his friends, his close relatives, his parents, his playmates, neighbours and other aspects of life as they come to his memory. We often assist him to cut short the prayer, so as to enjoy a hot meal. **Luka** is friendly and is loved by his fellow kids in our

Once again, thank you for all your love, prayers, and unwavering support for us".



Currently in the field for his practicum, **Isaiah** is completing his Post Graduate Diploma in Legal Practice at the Law Development Center.


He will be done within the next one week. The finality of his entire course will be February 2025 when he receives his ultimate results. Then he can settle down and practice as a Lawyer.



**Isaiah** is a steady driver, and thus very helpful to us at home and at church, in






At church, **Abigail** is active, leading music in worship every Sunday, and other fellowship times organized by the members of our church.

# The PT Aspect of our Ministry

Beyond our weekly engagements, the last major ministry activity at the PT Center was the Women's Conference in May. And there have been a few other ministry activities, initiated and conducted by our ministry partners. As the core facet of the **Proclamation Task**, the **PT Institute** will hopeful grow to anchor our wider engagement, by offering the formal qualification for non-formal trainers and ministry practitioners in local churches, school settings, market-place workers and para-church entities.



We keep in touch with a number of people who participate in our training events and we are encouraged by the ministry engagements in their localities.

We are especially encouraged to get reports that include how the women are building their homes, serving in their local churches, and living as godly examples for Christian witness.

Again, for the needed "tap root", the direction of our training is pointed to the **Institute**, which will serve as the anchor of our wider engagement, offering the needed formal qualification for the non-formal engagement, of generally and collectively equipping the



saints for the work of service as godly practitioners, to the glory of God.



We are now living in a time of rapid change at all levels and all facets of life, and on a global scale. As God would have it, and just like in every generation, Gospel opportunities are embedded in what we perceive as the overall challenges and obstacles, even amidst chaos!

There is dire need for us to turn such challenges into opportunities for the advancement of God's kingdom. Given that the majority of Gospel workers in our context are without basic training towards ministry, our formal program will sustain and nurture their non-formal training, sufficient for both outreach, and a sustained discipleship in their various contexts.



We hold firmly that trainees ought to launch from a solid Bible base, in order to fruitfully interact with a broad base in our fast-changing world. We desire to see them addressing the pressing and relevant issues in their cultural contexts, for a direct and practical impact on an expanding scale. Since the Fall of man (Genesis 3), our "human needs" remain the Gospel channel, and understanding the contextual is a valued gambit.



In the recent past, our other partners have used the PT Center for their ministry events, including the Baptist Union of Uganda (BUU) for the Youth Conference.

As our world becomes increasingly connected, the

task of relating cross-culturally and seeking to communicate the Gospel in multi-cultural contexts is increasingly pressing. Such realities mark our constant reflection, for better engagement.

The PT Center is increasingly being utilized by other partnering organizations who share in our ideals of the Gospel and its proclamation in the world. And it is our joy to realise growth over the years, to this achievement.

















We continue to improve the PT Center as a comprehensive amenity for Christian service, as God builds His church among us and through us. More and more partners in Gospel ministry are making arrangements to hold their events on this site, and locally generating some income for PT.

# **Construction Update**

We can now affirm that it was very helpful to give attention to the perimeter wall and the main gate. This locality used to be a traditional village 20 years ago when we acquired the property. And now, there has been a rapid urbanization of this area, bustling with a large and mixed populace. It has made this area insecure, with active and jobless young men. So, the fence (though incomplete) and the gate, were timely.



Although the perimeter wall around our ten acres is not yet complete to the planed height, it has greatly improved safety of people and property within, and prohibited trespass. We have a contract with a security company which provides two men (at any one time), to keep our premises safe from intruders and break-ins. We also installed solar lights for improved security at night.

At the moment, construction is in progress at the PT Center, focused on upgrading

accommodation. Following is the pictorial of the currently ongoing construction.





We are currently working on the second floor of the Triplex, in order to improve housing / accommodation on this site.













This phase of construction is perhaps the most expensive part, both by building materials and labor costs. Procurement of materials and the effort of bringing them to the right size, shape, positioning and lay-out is quite involving and precarious.









But for every step in this construction, progress is uplifting for us, as we anticipate the fruit of training activity within this facility, for years to come.









On a daily basis, we register wonderful progress, worthy of thanksgiving to God. Each phase of construction activity is a helpful reminder of our history – God's call on our lives, rallying like-minded brothers and sisters around this cause, to equip the saints, now linking us with heavenward, with such joy and gladness of accomplishment.

## **Our Projection for this construction**






